The Christmas Story (Christmas Oratorio)

The charming Schütz Christmas oratorio titled "The Birth of our Lord Jesus Christ" ("Die Geburt unsers Herren Jesu Christi") was first performed in 1660, and features beautifully defined solos from a group of characters in the Christmas story. One is the angel who urges Joseph to rouse himself and take Mary to Bethlehem for safety. Another is the evil king Herod, who claims that he wants to find the child king so he can worship him. In reality, Herod has far more evil plans. The shepherds are excited to go to Bethlehem to see the wonderous thing they have heard. The three wise men also take a bow, and sing a lively trio that asks, "Where is the newborn King of the Jews?" And the final chorus, "Now give we all thanks to God" is a masterpiece in its own right.
