Volunteer Opportunities

Rehearsals:

- Setup on Tuesday evenings (as needed)
- Tear down at end of rehearsal (as needed)

Concerts:

- Setup stage: Typically 9:00 - 11:30 am on Concert days
- Tear down: Immediately after concert for approx. 1 hour
- Stuff programs: Sometime during concert set up window
- Batteries in stand lights: Sometime during concert set up window
- Ushering: Available for friends and family (except at Elsinore)
- Ticket sales/collection: Available for friends and family (except at Elsinore)

Membership:

- Plan concert after-parties
- Help with ticket sales for members during the term

Marketing & Promotion:

- Distribute flyers/posters

Administrative Help:

- Assemble mailings

Recruitment:

- 2 or 3 hour shift at the Art Fair in September
- 2 hour shift at the Farmer's Market - various Saturdays during the Spring/Summer
